### Winter Convention 2018

Winter Convention 2018 - Penni and the group are extremely busy with final plans and preparations for the convention. All committee chairs will travel to Branson on 17 Feb to do the final walkthrough and planning for the show. Please let Penni know if you plan on attending the activities on the 17th so we know who to expect and what all we want to look at. This will be our final opportunity to see the venue and adjust our plan to make the show a success. We have exceeded expectations on the number of registered guests for the hotel, so if you call, the advertised rate may not be available for all three nights, this is a good and bad problem (LOL). The hotel will offer a reduced rate for their premium rooms, but they cannot match the advertised rates for these larger rooms. The trips have also been a great success, we have added additional buses for the Dixie Stampede to satisfy demand. Our goal is to not turn anyone away from the trips. Currently we have roughly 220+ signed up for the banquet on Saturday night and we are getting more each day. The Auction has also been the subject of the nightly barrage of calls, what can I bring, how much can I bring? We have set the commission at 15%, you can either donate or consign items, but they must be IH. Now is the time to sell anything IH you have determined to be excess in your collection. Early registration of items will start on Thursday afternoon with main push being Friday. Items should be easily transported, we do not recommend tractors or heavy parts that would require heavy equipment to move the item. It is our hope that vendors will begin to register now that the New Year is underway and the event is looming on the horizon. While we have a wide variety of vendors registered, we hope to have many more register before the end of the month. The deadline for sponsor ship and advertising is also very near, as the program must go to printer soon.
